## **2023 NAHASDA Income Limits**

If the HUD income for a county/parish located within a Native American service area is lower than the United States median, you may use the United States median income limit. The United States median income limit for FY 2023 is \$96,200. Therefore the adjusted income limit for family size and percent of median income is as follows:
