Housing Assistance for Veterans Program

The Housing Assistance for Veterans (HAVEN) is a grant program offered through FHLB Dallas members that helps fund home modifications and repairs for United States veterans, active-duty, reserve and National Guard service members who became disabled as a result of their military service since September 11, 2001 (9/11). Besides service members, HAVEN funds can also be awarded to Gold Star families, which are families who have lost loved ones to military service since 9/11. Households with income of 165 percent or less of the area median income may qualify.



More to Give

With an easy application process and flexible qualification criteria, HAVEN is a grant program that is easily attainable for those it was created. Veterans, their families or nonprofits can all apply through FHLB Dallas members, to be connected to opportunities that will provide not only improvements to living situations, but also peace of mind.

Rebuilding Lives

The HAVEN grant can be used for a multitude of things:

- Home repairs to meet the needs of a U.S. veteran or service member
- Offsetting construction costs
- Paying for third-party inspection costs, up to the lesser of 15 percent of the total modification cost or \$500
- Different types of home modifications (i.e. Installation of grab bars in bathrooms, adding wheelchair ramps, lowering countertops)

BENEFITS

- Enables members to help veterans in their communities
- Qualifies for CRA credit
- Up to **\$10,000** granted toward repairs or rehab of a property
- Funds may be applied to modifications on properties located anywhere in the United States.
