



DISASTER REBUILDING ASSISTANCE (DRA)

Through member institutions, Disaster Rebuilding Assistance (DRA) provides funds for the repair, rehabilitation and reconstruction of owner-occupied housing affected by disasters in federally declared disaster areas within the Federal Home Loan Bank of Dallas' (FHLB Dallas) five-state District of Arkansas, Louisiana, Mississippi, New Mexico and Texas.

New in 2024: Two Offerings

- Two offerings with \$1.25 million released in January and \$1.25 million released in July
- Administered on a first-come, first-served basis until funds are exhausted
- Any remaining funds available at the end of the first offering will carry over to the second offering
- The member cap for 2024 will be \$350,000, with an initial limit of \$175,000 during the first offering

Application Period and Limits

- Members may apply until November 15, 2024, or until funds exhausted, whichever occurs first
- Maximum award per household is \$12,000
- Please use the 2024 DRA Program Funding Manual when submitting requests

How to Apply

Members must first enroll in DRA before applying. To enroll, request the Disaster Rebuilding Assistance enrollment package be sent via Adobe Sign by submitting a request using the contact form located [here](#) or by emailing ahp@fhlb.com.

Homeowner Qualifications

Homeowners must be at or below 80 percent of the area median income

The property must be the applicant's primary residence

The repairs, rehabilitation or reconstruction isn't covered by insurance or other funding sources
