## Grant Relief

• Direct and Immediate Disbursement	
• <i>Donation to Red Cross and other organizations</i>	<b><i>\$0.5 million</i></b>
• Disbursement through Member Institutions	
• <i>Homeowners: Housing Grant</i>	<b><i>\$4.5 million</i></b>
• <i>Small Business: Economic Development Grants</i>	<b><i>\$2.0 million</i></b>
• <i>Community Organizations: Partnership Grants</i>	<b><i>\$0.225 million</i></b>
• <i>Other</i>	<b><i>\$0.175 million</i></b>
<b><u>Total Grants</u></b>	<b><u>\$7.5 million</u></b>

# Harvey Recovery Grant Programs

## ❖ Review the Grant programs:

- Homeowner Recovery: \$4.5 million in grants to assist members' employees.
- Small Business Recovery: \$2.0 million to assist small businesses
- Community Recovery: \$225,000 to assist non-profits working on housing and economic recovery effort
- Will accept applications for all three grant programs starting September 15 at 8:00 a.m. (CT)

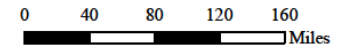
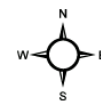


**Data Layer/Map Description:**

# Homeowner Recovery Grants: \$4.5 million

- Eligibility Criterion

- Owner-occupied homes that have been damaged or destroyed
- Located in a designated disaster county

- Eligibility Amounts per household

- Contingent on household income
- Household Income  $\leq$  80% AMI, grant up to \$10,000
- Household Income  $>$  80% and  $\leq$  120%, grant up to \$8,000
- Household Income  $>$ 120% and  $\leq$  165%, grant up to \$6,000

- Order of Grant Disbursement

- Opened to **Member Employees exclusively** until **November 15th**
  - First-come, first-served until funds are exhausted
- Opened to General Public after November 15<sup>th</sup> if available funds
  - First-come, first-served until funds are exhausted

- Grant limit per Member Institution

- Aggregate Homeowner Grants per Member not to exceed \$150,000

# Small Business Recovery Grants

- Eligibility Criteria
  - Located in a designated disaster county
  - Small business has incurred damage or been destroyed
  - Qualify as small business as defined by the SBA
  - Funds can be used only for resumption of business
  - Located in a census tract at or below 120% of AMI
- Grant limit per Small Business
  - Maximum grant per small business: \$15,000
- Order of Grant Disbursement
  - First-come, first-served until funds are exhausted
- Grant limit per Member Institution
  - Aggregate Small Business Recovery Grants per Member not to exceed \$150,000

# Community Based Organization Recovery Grants

- Eligibility Criteria
  - CBO must be in a county designated as a disaster
  - CBO must have a 501c3 IRS designation
  - CBO must be assisting in recovery efforts from Harvey
  - CBO must be involved in affordable housing, stimulating small business or providing small business technical asst.
- Grant limit per CBO
  - Maximum grant per CBO: \$10,000
- Order of Grant Disbursement
  - First-come, first-served until funds are exhausted
- Grant limit per Member Institution
  - Aggregate CBO Recovery Grants per Member not to exceed \$30,000



# Application Process

- Submit the applicable **application(s)** and supporting **documentation** to Member Services via email.
- Applications must be signed by an individual on the FHLB Dallas **advances signature card**.
- After the request(s) is approved, the funds will be deposited into the members FHLB Dallas **DDA account**.
- The Homeowner application can contain requests for multiple employees.
- The Business and Community applications must be completed for each business or CBO assisted.
